- I acknowledge that I have the necessary experience and training to operate high-power rockets at my current level of certification.
- I agree to hold harmless the Tripoli Rocketry Association Inc. and the launch site landowner for any liability resulting from my participation and actions of others at this rocket launch including any bodily injury.

BROTHERS OREGON LAUNCH SITE RELEASE & DISCHARGE, ACCEPTANCE OF RESPONSIBILITY & ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF RISKS

In order to attend an event at the Brothers, Oregon Launch Site, located at 33395 Highway 20, Brothers, Oregon (hereinafter "the Launch Site") you must read, understand, sign, and return this Release and Discharge, Acceptance of Responsibility, and Acknowledgment of Risks form. Individuals under the age of 18 must be in the company of a parent or guardian who accepts responsibility and signs this form on their behalf.

Acknowledgment of Risks and Acceptance of Responsibility. I acknowledge and agree that certain aspects of attending a rocket launch at the Launch Site may be dangerous and involve the risk of serious injury and/or death and/or property damage to participants or bystanders. Some of the risks include, but are not limited to, rocket "failure" resulting in a rocket veering off course, over-pressurizing or falling from the sky onto my person or property, and shade devices and other items being picked up by the wind and deposited onto my person or property. Additional risks of attending a launch at the Launch Site include the inhospitable and harsh environment, exposure to the elements, exposure to trash and debris, including broken glass and shards of metal, exposure to natural hazards such as brush, rocks and uneven ground, and/or interaction or attack by or wild animals. I further understand that I will participate in any activities held at the Launch Site at my own risk, and further agree that I will exercise the utmost care in pursuit of my activities while at the Launch Site and will comply with any and all applicable rocketry safety codes as outlined by Tripoli and/or NAR.
