#### Oregon Rocketry's Premiere Family Launch

Fillible's Folly flies from farmland just 45 miles southwest of Portland, in the community of **Sheridan, OR**. As our only high power launch in the Willamette Valley it draws a larger community of fliers than most high power launches in Brothers and is the perfect venue to loft your rocketry up from park fliers to mid and high power!

#### Garden Home Park 8320 SW 83<sup>rd</sup> Ave, Portland

Garden Home launches are free to the public, sanctioned under the National Association of Rocketry, and happen on the second Saturday of every month from April to November, except September. These family-friendly launches run from 10am to 1pm, and are the perfect place for new fliers to come launch with guidance from our community of experts. Flights at the park are limited to model rockets flying on up to B motors, C with permission.

Brothers — A remote high desert range 41 miles east of Bend on Hwy 20. You can fly it all here from model rockets to high power level 3. Over a mile and a half of separation from the highway affords plenty of airspace and recovery range!

Sheridan — Home of the Fillible's Folly launch, is located about 45 miles SW of Portland on a sprawling field. Separation from nearby roads and ample recovery space allows opportunity for large rockets, up to level 2 high power flights.

Launch Fees — Our launch weekend fees are \$10 individual low power, \$20 individual high power, or \$30 for the whole family! Club members fly free. Viewing is free at all launches other than NXRS.

Amenities — All of our launch sites offer toilet facilities. Brothers and Sheridan have limited—unimproved—camping and vendors.

NXRS starts a day earlier.
